*Colossians 1:9 we have not ceased to pray for you*  
*1 Timothy 2:8 I want the men in every place to pray*  
*James 5:16 pray for one another*  
*1 Thessalonians 5:25 Brethren, pray for us*

### #2 The Word of God is the best \_\_\_\_\_ to make you PRAY <sub>2</sub>

*Jeremiah 25:11-12 And this whole land shall be a desolation and a horror, and these nations shall serve the king of Babylon seventy years. 12 Then it will be when seventy years are completed I will punish the king of Babylon and that nation,' declares the Lord,' for their iniquity, and the land of the Chaldeans; and I will make it an everlasting desolation.*  
*Jeremiah 29:10 For thus says the Lord, 'When seventy years have been completed for Babylon, I will visit you and fulfill My good word to you, to bring you back to this place.*

**1<sup>st</sup> Deportation 605 BC**  
**2<sup>nd</sup> Deportation 597BC**  
**3<sup>rd</sup> Deportation 586 BC**

### #3 Submission to God's \_\_\_\_\_ gives you the heart to PRAY <sub>2</sub>

*Daniel 2:21 it is He who changes the times and the epochs; He removes kings and establishes kings;*  
*Daniel 4:35b But He does according to His will in the host of heaven. And among the inhabitants of earth;*  
*And no one can ward off His hand Or say to Him, 'What hast Thou done?'*

*Luke 22:42 Father, if Thou art willing, remove this cup from Me; yet not My will, but Thine be done.*  
*1 John 5:14 ...if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. 15 And if we know that He hears us in whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests which we have asked from Him.*  
*James 1:5 But if any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all men generously and without reproach, and it will be given to him.*  
*James 4:3 You ask and do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, so that you may spend it on your pleasures.*

*Romans 8:26 says in the same way the Spirit also helps our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we should, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words*
